

1<sup>st</sup> Workshop of the ICARUS Didactic Work Group  
Poznań, 6<sup>th</sup> June 2011

The coordinator of the new Work Group, Antonella Ambrosio (University of Naples Federico II), opened the session welcoming the participants and describing the goals of the group.

Antonella Ambrosio also gave the first talk and spoke of the “Learning Community” organized by UNINA which connects young graduates, PhD candidates and students via seminars and newsletters and aims at training MOMCa editors.

The following speaker, Maria Rosaria Falcone (University of Naples Federico II), reported on the “The coordination of training for the digital archive of Biblioteca della Società Napoletana di Storia Patria”, describing in particular the organization of the training. The participants, members of the Monasterium Learning Community, partook in a series of seminars and workshops on XML encoding for digital archives. Four trainees then transformed the acquired knowledge into practical experience by processing the metadata of the archive.
